



SUPERMARINE SPITFIRE MKI Paper/card model


Spiral wind parts 19, 20, and 21 onto rounded toothpicks or similar material.



Spiral wind onto rounded toothpick or similar material.




Spiral wind onto rounded toothpick or similar material.

The supermarine spitfire was the brainchild of Sir Reginald Mitchell. The aircraft was based on a specifications by the Air Ministry. In 1936, the prototype was first flown. The Spitfire came with various variant and the production of the first one, Mk1, began in July 1938. The final version, #24 was last delivered in 1947.
